Beginning a Vegetable Garden

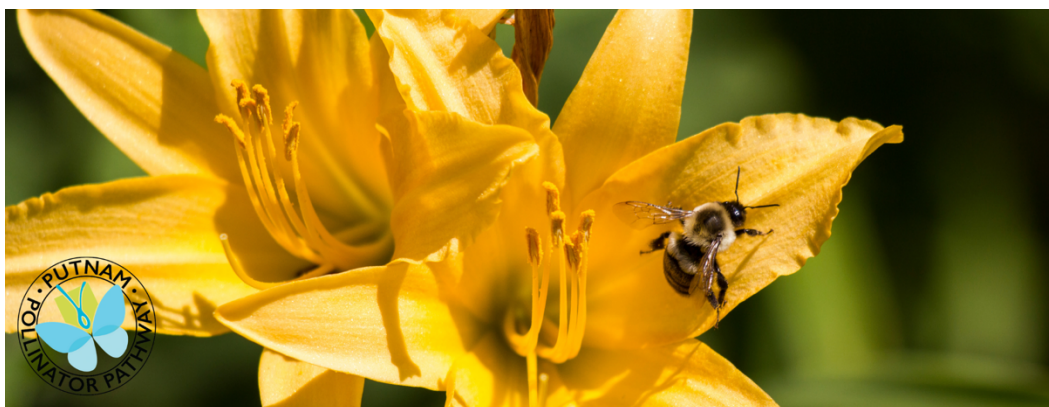
